Additional information.

For Nomination from the Floor to the Bishop's Committee:

A person can nominate herself or himself or have another offer the nomination. The Nominee must be a qualified elector.

A second is not required.

Form: I nominate *Name/Myself* to serve on the Bishop's Committee.

If persons are nominated from the Floor to become Members of the Bishop's Committee:

The Nominating Committee has offered 2 persons to serve for two years. If we have 3 or more standing for election we'll vote by ballot. The two persons with the highest vote totals (if they have a majority vote of qualified electors) will be elected.

For Nomination from the Floor to be an Alternate to Diocesan Convention:

The Nominating Committee has offered 2 persons to serve as Delegates and 2 persons to serve as Alternates. If we have 3 or more standing for election to serve as Delegate or Alternate, we'll vote by ballot. The two persons with the highest vote totals (if they have a majority vote of qualified electors) will be elected as Delegate or Alternate in accordance with their nomination as Delegate or Alternate.

A person can nominate herself or himself or have another offer the nomination. The Nominee must be willing to serve, be a qualified elector, and a communicant in good standing.

A second is not required.

Form (choose one):

I nominate *Name/Myself* to serve as a Delegate to Diocesan Convention.

Or

I nominate Name/Myself to serve as an Alternate to Diocesan Convention.
